Article X: Scheduling Section 4.

"Staff members may request in advance of schedule making that they may be given specific dates or hours free of work."

State of the Local

In Progress

- Currently, Local 1930 is waiting for audits for 2021 and 2020 to be completed by an independent auditor. More information to come.
- Contract Renegotiation status is currently unknown. We're waiting for updates from DC 37. More information to come.
- Local 1930 elections and vacancies:
 - Trustee (three-year term) One Trustee position shall be up for re-election. Trustees at least annually oversee the local's finances and report the audit results to the membership. Trustees are not members of the E-Board (Executive Broad).
 - Chief Shop Steward The local's <u>Constitution</u> states, in Section 7.
 "The elected President shall appoint the Chief Library Steward with the approval of the Executive Board." Please <u>click here</u> if interested in being nominated and for more details about the position.

SCHOLARSHIP

As long as the treasury permits, up to ten (10) \$1000 scholarships are given annually. Postgraduate study is required for five of the scholarships. All recipients of the scholarships must be a member in good standing with a permanent appointment. The guidelines for these scholarships will be written in a letter and sent to the membership.

STUDENT DEBT FUND

As long as the treasury permits, up to ten (10) \$1000 stipends are given annually. All recipients of the stipends must be a member in good standing with a permanent appointment and at least three years of service. The stipend guidelines will be written in a letter and sent to the membership.
